These short-grass plains stretch from the western side of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area to the southeast Serengeti National Park.

Your private safari is run at a leisurely pace. Choose to wake early and head out on a morning game drive, returning for lunch and a siesta at camp before venturing out again on a sunset drive. Or opt for a full day out, complete with picnic lunch. That's the best part of a private trip – you get to safari your way. So do give your private guide your safari wish list – including all the animals / birds you would love to see. They'll do their best to help you tick off everything on your list! Brief itinerary:

Day 1	Fly from Kilimanjaro Airport to Ndotu Airstrip. You'll be met on arrival by your private guide and safari vehicle and transferred to Ndotu Wilderness Camp. Overnight for 4 nights including all meals and selected drinks.
Days 2-4	Spend leisurely days exploring the Ndotu region. Enjoy morning/ afternoon or full day game drives. Optional Hot Air Balloon Safari can be booked at an additional fee.
Day 5	Transfer after breakfast to Ndotu Airstrip for your flight back to Kilimanjaro Airport.

Detailed itinerary:

Day 1-5: Ndotu Wilderness Camp, Ndotu

Your flight from Kilimanjaro Airport to Ndotu kick starts your private Tanzania safari. Flight takes +- an hour.

You'll be met on arrival by your private guide and safari vehicle and transferred to Ndotu Wilderness Camp.

Ndotu lies in the northern part of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The surrounding landscapes are covered in sweeping grasslands which provide the perfect habitat for the migratory route for hundreds of thousands of wildebeest, antelope and zebra. Explore the forest around Lake Ndotu, spotting an array of wildlife; common species include leopard, lion, cheetah, caracal, serval, African wildcat, and prolific birdlife.

Overnight: Ndotu Wilderness Camp for 4 nights

This intimate, comfortable tented camp is available in the Ndotu area of the Serengeti ecosystem typically from December—March, which coincides with the ‘calving season’. It is placed in a private site, in the heart of the Ndotu plains and nestled under shady trees. Plenty of predators can be found year-round in this area. The diverse eco-systems within the Ndotu area - from woodlands to plains and soda lakes - make it a unique place for bird watching.

The unfenced camp comprises just ten spacious tents (including a family tent/ triple available), all with solar lighting and ensuite facilities (flushing toilet and shower). Comfortable beds with quality linen ensure a good night’s rest.

Our professional staff are on hand to look after your every need, and our safari chef will prepare wholesome and varied meals during your stay at the camp. Meals are served in a large dining tent or alfresco. The central lounge and bar area is a sociable place for relaxing in, and the camp has complimentary WiFi.

Days 2-4: Ndotu eco-system

Spend the next few days enjoying game drives in and around the Ndotu area, where beautiful open plains and plenty of resident game allow for ideal photo opportunities.

Optional extra: Hot Air Balloon Safari

Day 5: End of Itinerary

THE MIGRATION EXPLAINED:

The following should be used as a guideline when planning your safari to East Africa – movement of wildlife depends on a great many aspects. The following migration calendar helps to explain the seasonality of game viewing. Remember there is resident game throughout the year in the Serengeti/Ngorongoro eco-systems.



JAN / FEB / MARCH

The large herds of wildebeest are generally in the southern plains of the Serengeti eco-system, calving takes place over approximately two weeks. An abundance of predators, good visibility of game, mix of open plains and some woodland.

APRIL / MAY

The herds start moving toward central Serengeti. This is typically the rainy season, however, game viewing is still excellent and there are some great discounts available at lodges and camps. It generally doesn't rain all day. Conditions for photography are generally superb with moody skies and good depth of colour.

JUNE / JULY / AUGUST

The wildebeest move from the central area and split to the west and north, continuing their trek toward the Mara River. River crossings may be seen in both the western corridor (Grumeti area) and north (Mara River).

SEPTEMBER / OCTOBER

Whilst some of the wildebeest successfully reach the Masai Mara, there are still hundreds of thousands remaining in the northern region of Serengeti, offering those with guests with loads of patience the chance to see exciting river crossings (the Mara River runs through the Serengeti).

NOVEMBER / DECEMBER

The massive herds start to return from the north down to the southern plains, before the cycle repeats again!

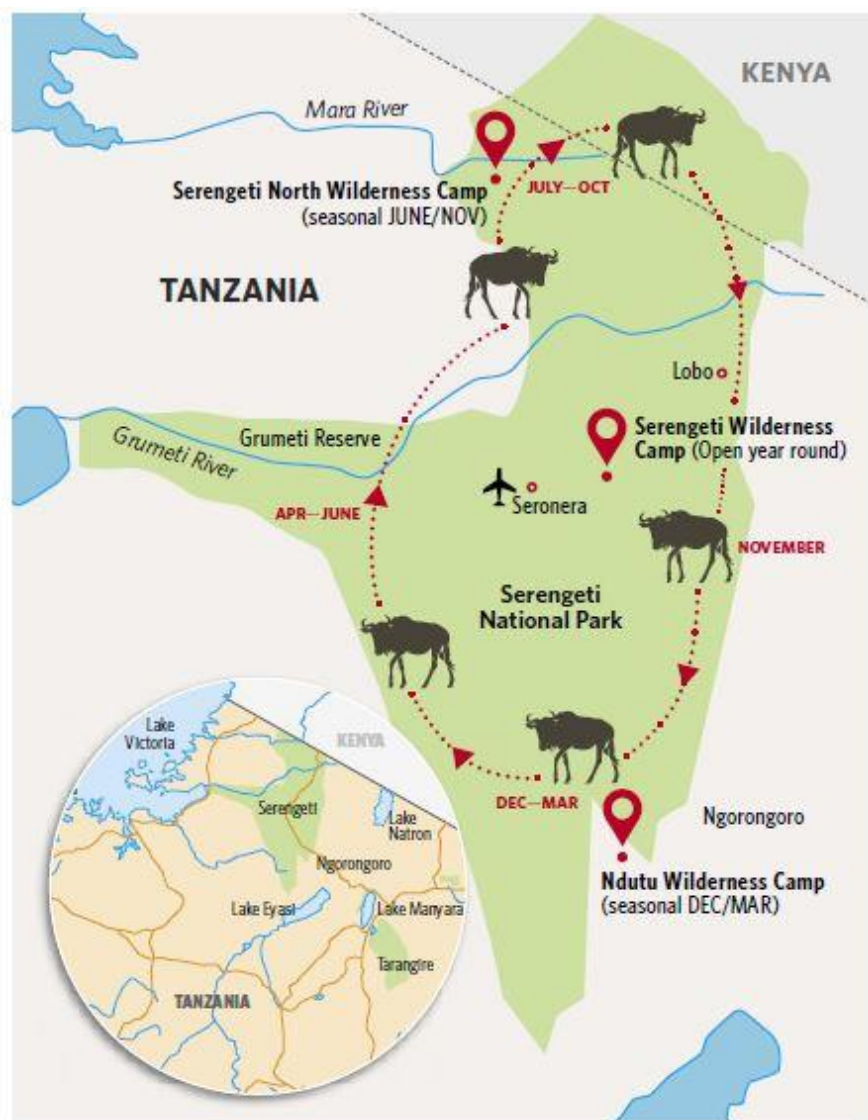
TRAVEL INSURANCE: Is compulsory for all guests travelling with Wild Frontiers.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Yellow fever vaccines are no longer required to enter Tanzania unless you have been via an endemic area. However, on the ground, it often differs and you may be asked for Yellow Fever certificate, even if you have only been in transit via Nairobi. We strongly suggest you have a Yellow Fever vaccination, as regulations can change and often staff at border posts have the incorrect information on this, which can cause delays. (For a list of countries with risk of yellow fever transmission and countries requiring yellow fever vaccination click [here](#)) Precautions against Malaria are also recommended.

VISA REQUIREMENTS: All visitors to Tanzania must have a valid passport which needs to be valid for 6 months after return date of travel and have at least 3 blank pages in it. Except for exempted countries all visitors require a visa to enter Tanzania. South Africans visiting on holiday currently do not require a visa. Visas are currently US\$ 50 per person, single entry for most other nationalities. An exception is US citizens for whom a single-entry visa is US\$100

Visitors should apply via the e-visa portal: <https://eservices.immigration.go.tz/visa>.

Visas are issued within 2 - 3 weeks.
