Features like double vs single wall, peak height, and floor space can influence your experience whilst camping on the edge of a mountain. At the bare minimum a 4-Season, double walled (for better temperature control) tent is required to be comfortable during your 5 and more nights' camping expedition.

Some nice-to-haves are an extra door for airflow, higher peak height, and vestibules (covered areas next to your tent door for convenience).
